

Crop Early Globe - Onion



Crop Early Globe (CEG) is an early maturing globe onion cultivar with medium storage life

Performance benefits

- Larger bulb size than Early Long Keeper (ELK)
- Better globe-shaped bulb than ELK
- Matures one week earlier than ELK
- 12 % higher yield than ELK
- 15% higher first grade than ELK
- Lower fertiliser (N) requirement than other cultivars
